CALL TO ORDER

Wayne Olsen, Mayor called meeting to order at 6:00p.m.

RECOGNITION OF VISITORS

NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Olsen presented the council with Ordinance No. 461 Use of Tourist Park to be approved. Questions and concerns from the council about Ordinance No. 461 were addressed.

Councilman Mangum made a motion to approve, councilman Wallin seconded it. The motion passed unanimously. Mayor Olsen then read the Ordinance.

Mayor Olsen presented the council with Resolution 20-04 Tourist Park Use Fees to be approved. Questions and concerns from the council about Resolution 20-04 were addressed.

Councilman Wallin made a motion to approve, councilman Wall seconded it. The motion passed unanimously. Mayor Olsen then read the Resolution.

Three individuals were on the agenda, Neal Andersen, Ted Smith, and Tim Techeik were not in attendance of the council meeting.

Mayor Olsen presented to the council Natalie Perez to serve as City Clerk/Treasurer.

Councilman Wallin made a motion to approve, councilman Mangum seconded it. The motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Olsen presented to the council Chardon Hartley to serve as Public Works Supervisor.

Councilman Wallin made a motion to approve, councilman Mangum seconded it. The motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Reports

Councilman Wall: O.W. Park, industrial park- received a bid for \$1200 for sprinkler system at O.W Park, Mayor Olsen requested that there be another bid, Konnex area needs heat tape on a water pipe, approval from Mayor Olsen for Wendall West to do the work. Councilman Wall requested that building permits start being sent to council members, so they know what is going on in the community.

Councilman Wallin: City water and sewer-Nothing new at this time, will work with Chardon and Duane and will follow up with council at next meeting.

Councilman Mangum: Parks department- need to get the merry-go-round at the kid's park removed completely for winter, get it welded together and plan on replacing it correctly in the spring. Councilman Mangum will also plan on welding the gate at the tourist park.


Mayor's Report

He needs a list of Business park leases and when they are expired. The Grant Application was mailed today for resurfacing city streets. The Tourist Park Camping Space on line reservation program has an updated map with 24 RV spaces, including the annex; limiting where and how many campers can be in campsites. The Mayor reported the City was having problems with collecting the Local 3% non-property tax from several businesses..
