

ORDINANCE NO. 438
Court Costs for Ordinance Violations

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MACKAY, CUSTER COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO; CITY ORDINANCES HAVE ESTABLISHED FINES OR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION; PROVIDING THAT COURT COST INCURRED AS A RESULT OF FINES RESULTING FROM VIOLATION(S) OF CITY OF MACKAY ORDINANCES SHALL BE PAID BY THE VIOLATOR; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MACKAY, CUSTER COUNTY, IDAHO:

SECTION 1: For any person having been found by the Court of violating an Ordinance of the City of Mackay punishable as an infraction, Court Costs or fees as set by Idaho Code or Court Rules as applicable, and as amended from time to time shall be assessed and imposed by the Court in addition to any set fine or penalty prescribed by Ordinances of the City of Mackay pursuant to Idaho Code §18-113A.
