<u>CALL TO ORDER - Mayor Mangum called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.</u> Recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

SHERIFF'S REPORT – A lot more patrolling. Three officers now. Car parked on highway – good deterrent. Several of us commented on how we appreciate your officers patrolling our areas. Detention deputies are brand new positions. Fires have slowed down except for the counties which are still hopping. New fire hall across the street turned into Emergency Management, lower end is search and rescue upper end is sheriff's office. Now have empty office space for patrol officers to do paperwork or interviews. Sheriff's contract. We tentatively budgeted \$42,436.00 for the sheriff's office. Will look for the contract and revise that and get a copy sent up.

<u>LRED</u> – Moved into social media phase. More things showing up on Facebook page. Corporate fund package just putting final polishing on it. Commercial property hasn't changed. Event update – trick-or-treat walk. BBQ was successful 1600 people showed. Mike Evans is rep for KCat team. New member Terry Rodriguez who replaced Eric Estrada. Mine has finished prefeasibility study which can be found on Phoenix Copper's website. Looking at 2026 for start up and looking at 8 year project. 104 F/T employees. Wages will commensurate with Elko, NV non union mining wages. Need agreement with mine – how much are they going to help with infrastructures. Had kickoff meeting to get ideas on the table already. Engineering infrastructure analysis completed. Plan of operation needs to be submitted for comment.

Payroll – Change. Currently pay in real time. Should be paying at least a week in arrears. Needs to be paid 2 weeks in arrears. Motion to authorize Mayor and Clerk to work payroll out in area that it works out. Coucilwoman Hames 2^{nd} – council passed.

Motion for executive session D. Wall, K. Hames 2nd. Roll call Dean Wall – yes, Karen Hames – Yes, Suzanne Whitworth – yes, Mike Foster – Yes. Motion to come out of executive session back to regular session M. Foster, 2nd by S. Whitworth, Council passed.

Based on discussion Councilman Foster makes a Motion to offer Duane a 1099 contract for maintenance work for the City of Mackay and as part of that contract he will submit his weekly hours. The amount worked will be called "as needed" as determined by Chardon. 2nd by Councilwoman Hames – council passed.

Suzanne Whitworth – **Streets** – Really need to get working on the arrears. Need to do at least five a week. Need to do five delinquent accounts and/or empty lots. Would like to give Jacoda something for his time. Jacoda needs to submit a bill and we can pay.
