November 10, 2025, 6:00 p.m. – 203 S Main, Mackay, ID

### 1. CALL TO ORDER (Idaho Code §50-707)

### 5. APPROVAL OF MINUTES (Idaho Code §50-707; §74-205)

### 6. PUBLIC COMMENT (Idaho Code §74-201)

Sheriff Report - Handed out to council. Sheriff not in attendance. There was 248 patrol hours for Mackay.

LRED - Bob Bagley absent. Seemed like we had more kids trick-or-treating on Main St last year in the cold/stormy weather than we did this year in the nice weather.

### 7. REPORTS (Best practice – not statutory requirement)

- Mayor: Bridge is under way. Moving dirt and putting forms in. Talking about the 19<sup>th</sup> being completion date. Cathy Lambson says stop lights are too long. Can those be adjusted.

- Parks: Karen Hames will take charge of selling memorial plaques and putting funds in Parks Department for mowing/Fourth of July. Will work with Jennifer on forms and collection of money

- O.W. Bldg: Suzanne Whitworth suggested putting up a space available sign by the road so public would see it as they drive by. Complaints about White Knob and the road not being fixed.

- Water/Sewer: Mike Foster asked if we have made any headway with commercial accounts.

Richard stated that he has been working on it but with all the public records requests that are

coming in. Mike Foster suggested running an expense report and then a revenue report for each year and see if that will satisfy her needs.

Jet truck – Dean Wall suggested this be postponed until we speak to the auditors. Mike Foster suggested we plan accordingly for the budget as we are going to have a \$30,000 deficit for unpaid bills from previous years. Will get pricing for a meal. We have not needed the highway district a lot this year. Need to keep it with the city and those dealing with the day-to-day operations.

Bonuses – Get what we paid last year to council for December council meeting.
