Jared Lambson would like the City to pay \$1,000.00 towards Fourth of July event for next year. Use funds to pay someone to mow parks. Motion made by Mike Foster to authorize Karen Hames to work on placques for the Memorial Park with the revenue going to the Park Fund and the Fourth of July Fund, Seconded by Suzanne Whitworth. 


10. Adjournment
